



## **Downtown Fresh Air Food Court – Team Member (Part-time, Temporary)**

### **Job Description**

#### **General Description**

The Downtown Management District is looking to hire part time, temporary staff for its Fresh Air Food Court. Staff would be responsible for the daily setup, management, maintenance, and teardown of the outdoor dining area.

#### **Duties and Responsibilities**

- Reports to Food Court Supervisor
- Set up and Teardown of seating area
- Facilitate the seating of guests at available tables
- Clean and Disinfect all tables and chairs prior to initial use and after every use
- Maintain use of PPE throughout duration of shift
- Maintain cleanliness of area
- Other duties as required

#### **Requirements**

- Ability to meet the physical demands required by the position. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
- Ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Reliable transportation and punctuality
- Available days, evenings and weekends as scheduled
- Ability to communicate with supervisor, coworkers and public
- Display exceptional customer service
- Must be 18 years old or older

- \$10.00/Hourly up to 30 hours per week

*\* Staff is expected to arrive for their shifts on time. Staff must be prepared to stay on duty until relief staff has arrived and all responsibilities are complete.*

Mills Avenue between Oregon and Mesa Streets (Downtown El Paso).

**Dress Code:**

- Vest will be provided. It is the responsible for the staff to maintain their cleanliness.
- We recommend all participants wear light colored shorts or pants. Articles should not be revealing, torn, or frayed.
- Long sleeves and/or sunscreen are encouraged to be worn to protect from the sun. Generic hats are also encouraged.
- Closed-toe shoes are REQUIRED.
